School Uniform

Please ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform in school:

Boys: White polo shirt with badge, grey trousers, black shoes (not trainers)

Girls: Blue gingham dress, black sandals.

Both boys and girls should also have a school jumper/ cardigan.

Children may continue to wear PE kit on their PE day. PE kit should be in school daily for additional PE opportunities.

We expect our children to wear correct uniform and especially shoes as part of our uniform code. Children with long hair (girls and boys) should have it tied back and no earrings or jewellery should be worn to school.

Sending Money into school.

All monies sent into school should be contained in an envelope stating your child's name, class, amount and the purpose of the payment. Change cannot be given unfortunately. Over the course of the next year we will be phasing in, online payments for trips and residentials which will make payment a lot easier for yourselves and for us as a school to manage.
