A 10-YEAR-OLD Liverpool girl with remarkable football skills has her eyes set on becoming the next sport superstar.

Despite only playing for two years, Ava Roberts from Woolton has been selected to play in older boys' football teams.

Ava's mum Joanne Roberts said that she has always been sporty and enjoys athletics and dancing too.

Joanne told the ECHO: "She is always playing and practicing tricks. Even five minutes before her communion, when she was dressed up all nice, she was doing kick ups.

"I'm so proud of her - she works hard to do it as well, she doesn't

give up, she just carries on until she's got what she wants.

"She plays for the girls' team, but because she was so good they let her play for the boys' team sometimes.

"They won't allow girls to play with boys past a certain age, but she loves it and she is so confident."

Ava's favourite player is Mo Salah but she hopes that one day she will be like Toxteth-born professional footballer Nikita Josephine Parris, who used to play for Everton and Manchester City.

Speaking to the ECHO, Ava said: "I like it that much that I play it every day, all day. When I'm playing [with the ball] I feel that I can do anything."
