

Parents Evening - Zoom meeting School Cloud



Due to Coronavirus restrictions, we are currently unable to hold face-to-face meetings with parents as we normally would. Instead, the school has introduced a new initiative and easy to use online booking and video call system – "School Cloud." This allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers, book online and attend a web-based video call in place of a face-to-face meeting. Once your slot is booked you will receive an email confirming your appointment/s. You should have received a parent mail with full details of how to use School Cloud.. This meeting will focus on the well being of your child and how they have settled back into school routines.







Learning



Each week we will be displaying some of the work the children have completed in school. Look at some of the fantastic work the children have produced.







































