### Welcome to Reception!

Dear Parents,

Thank you all for a fabulous start to the school year! The children are beginning to settle into the routines of school life and they look very smart in their uniforms. Just a reminder that from Monday the children will stay for the whole day and have their lunch in school. Staff will be on hand to ensure the children learn the routines at lunch time and helping them to make choices.

Children should come to school in their PE kit each **Wednesday** morning from tomorrow (8<sup>th</sup> September). Please encourage them to dress independently at home too, fastening buttons and putting on their own jumpers/trousers/dresses whenever possible. This will help with their physical development. Please write your name in/on all of your child's belongings to avoid a trip to 'Lost Property'!

The children will be learning, exploring and playing in the outdoor area on a daily basis throughout the year, regardless of the weather! We therefore request that each child bring a pair of wellington boots and a coverall water-resistant suit to be kept in school for outdoor learning time. They will also need to wear a warm, waterproof coat to school each day for the same reason. Again, please label this with your child's name.

We ask that children bring a 'Book Bag' to school rather than a backpack or rucksack due to limited space in school. It also ensures that there is no competition between children when they all have the same. School book bags are available to buy through our uniform supplier, Stephen Tiffany. Children should bring a water bottle to school which should be clearly labelled with their name.

Children will begin to bring home reading books on a regular basis, but we will send out more detail about these in due course.
