Dear Parents,

Welcome to Year 4! We have had a brilliant first few days and the children have all settled in really well to their new class. We are looking forward to a fantastic year ahead!

Spelling lists are issued on a half termly basis and each list should be learnt for the date on the top of the list. Spellings will be tested on a Monday. Should you misplace your spelling list, you will find a copy on our school website on the Year 4 page and on Google Classrooms. Our online Spelling Shed resource will help the children to learn their spellings each week.

By the end of Year 4, the children are expected to know all of their times tables up to the 12x times tables. Times table tests will also take place on a Monday and lists will be sent out this week informing of the date each table will be tested. TT Rockstars will help to support learning of tables.

The children's reading will be heard daily during guided reading sessions. In addition to this, some children will also read daily with our LSA, Miss Reed. There is a basket in each class for books to be placed in on a Friday, record books must be signed by parents to say that they have heard their child read the book. Reading books will be changed by Miss Reed and new books will be sent home on a Monday. Children should be changing 1 book a week in Year 4.

Year 4's P.E. days are on Tuesday and Wednesday, children are allowed to come to school in the school P.E. kit and trainers.

KS2 children are permitted to bring in a snack to eat during morning play time. This should be fruit or other healthy options. Please remember to label all uniform including water bottles, coats and hats etc.
