

Year 2 Learning Journey

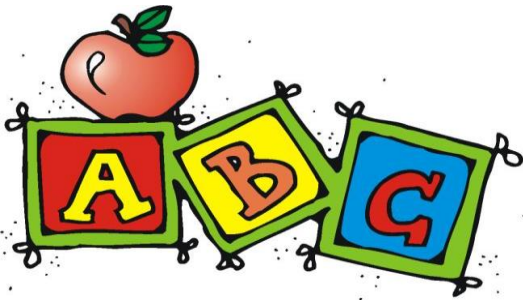
Autumn Term 1

English

We will be looking at descriptive writing and the features of this genre. We will also be focusing on grammar and punctuation which the children will be using in different activities and pieces of writing. In Read, Write Inc. we will continue to focus upon Set 2 and 3 sounds and writing for a variety of purposes.

Religious Education - Beginnings

Children will learn how new beginnings are important. The children will hear the story of creation and begin to recognise that God cares for everyone. We will look at different signs and symbols around us and how they are important to us. The children will look at the special signs associated with Baptism.



Science - Dinosaurs

This half term we will study dinosaurs! We will look at the characteristics of different dinosaurs, fossils, the job of archaeologists and the theory of extinction.

DT- Cookery

The children will be learning how to plan, prepare and cook a range of nutritious healthy meals and snacks.

Computing- Code-tastic

We will use a variety of programming apps/software to give children a practical understanding of how computer programs actually run, how a computer follows a sequence of instructions and what to do when a program goes wrong.

We will be revising basic skills this half term and counting in 2s, 3s, 5s etc

Geography - UK and Maps

The children will learn how to locate where places are in the UK, they will also be able to recognise places of interest. The children will identify similarities between places and be able to communicate their findings.

Our Sports coach Mr. Hathaway will continue developing the children's invasion game skills this half term. During our additional hour of PE, we hope to be playing team games outside, weather permitting! P.E kits to be worn on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
