This digraph may be used at the beginning, middle or end of words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Learn for a test on 15.11.21</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Spelling Rules: Long vowel sound /e/ spelt ee. The letters 'ee' make a long vowel sound like in the word see. This is a common way of spelling the sound and is found in the middle of words and sometimes at the end.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Learn for a test on 22.11.21</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Spelling Rules: The vowel digraph 'er'. In these words the sound is stressed.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Learn for a test on 29.11.21</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Spelling Rules: The vowel digraph 'er'. In these words the sound is unstressed and found at the end of words</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Learn for a test on 6.12.21</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Spelling Rules: The /ai/ and /oi/ digraphs. These digraphs are virtually never used at the end of words in English.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Learn for a test on 13.12.21</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Spelling Rules: The long vowel sound /oo/ as in zoo.</p>
