English
Street Child - This term the pupils will be reading the book 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty. The pupils, will be taught hom to write balanced anguments from the perspective of the main character. We will also explore namrative through the historical context of the booki Victorian time period. In our narnative we will focus on using Year 6 gramman features to enhance our descriptions.

Science
Light - This is the first science unit in Year 6 and the second time pupils mill have studied a physics focussed unit on light. The unit dives into both light and hom we see and penceive both objects and light itself - building on thein knombedge from Year 3.

Physical Education
Handball-This handball unit focuses on the main attacking and defending skills and fundamentals needed to play this fast and fur inwasion game. In offence, children will learn hom to throw and catch the ball, as well as move, pass and shoot. In defence, they will learn hom to mark and intercept.

Music
We will be working with the Anchdiocese of Liwerpool school's singing programme to develop a range singing techniques

Computing
E Safety - Pupils will be taught to explain hom sharing something online may have an impact either positively or negatively._They mill describe hom to be kind and shom respect for others online including the importance of respecting boundaries reganding what is shared about them online.

Mathematics
Four Operations - The pupils learning this term will centre around the four operations. Pupils will be taught to add and subtract integens, multiply 4 digits by 2 digits, shont division, division using factors, long division, common factors, common multiples, prime numbers, square and cube numbers, onder of operations, mental calculations, and reason from known facts.

Religious Education
Domestic Church Family-Loving-Students will focus on the relationship between the domestic chunch and the family union. They will share their experiences of Chunch through their our spinitual understanding of the topics covered.

Humanities
Ancient Egypt - In this unit, pupils will explore the ancient Egyptian civilisation and how over 30 dynasties created a successful Egypt throughout a 3000-year period. In undenstanding hom Egypt was ruled, pupils will begin to think about the signifficance of some notable phanachs and hom successful they were in leading Egypt.

RSE
The wonder of God's love in creating nem life- In this unit the pupils will learn all about the conception and development of a nem life. This term will focus on the social and emotional aspects of this.

PSHE
Being me in my world - In PSHE this term pupils will learn about how thein own wants and needs can compare with children in different communities. They will learn hom an individual's behaviour can impact on a, group.
