Welcome to Year 2

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Year 2! We have had a brilliant first week and the children have all settled in really well to their new class. We are looking forward to a fantastic year ahead!

Spelling lists are issued on a half termly basis and each list should be learnt for the date on the top of the list. Spellings will be tested on a Monday. Should you misplace your spelling list, you will find a copy on our school website on the Year 2 page. Our online Spelling Shed resource will help the children to learn their spellings each week.

The children are expected to know by heart their x2, x5 and x10 tables by the end of Year 2. We will begin to test the children after half term, starting with the x2 tables. Tables will also be tested on a Monday. TT Rockstars will help to support learning of tables.

The children are heard read daily through our RWI sessions. Some children will be heard read in addition to their guided session by our LSA, Mrs. Crennell. It is the responsibility of the children to ensure they hand their book in to be changed. There is a box in each class for books to be placed in on a Friday morning, record books must be signed by parents to say that they have heard their child read the book. New books will be sent home on a Monday. Children should be changing 1 book a week in Year 2.

Year 2's P.E. days are on Monday and Wednesday, children are allowed to come to school in their school P.E. kit and trainers.

There will be a short piece of English and Maths homework/activity each week for Year 2. This consolidates what we have taught in school. It will be set each Friday and should be completed and brought into the following Wednesday.



The KS1 children are all provided with a piece of fresh fruit each morning at break time. Children are allowed to bring a piece of fruit from home. Please remember to label all uniform including water bottles, coats and hats etc. (Lots of children have the same water bottles this year and most aren't labelled.) We have 3 school trips already planned and more information is to follow once costings have been finalised.

Our IT technician is in the process of updating our online systems as children are in now in their new classes. Once these are in place we will send reminder log ins home.
