# English

Our English work this term will be centred around the novel, 'A Christmas Carol' by Charles Dickens. The pupils will explore the themes, characters and structure of the novel before writing their own 'Christmas Ghost' narrative, poetry around the themes and a playscript. We will also be writing instructions based on The Grinch.

### Science - Forces

In our Forces unit of learning we will look closely at howforces act in the world around us – in our everyday lives without us even thinking about them. We will look at the difference between pushes and pulls, friction and resistance.

### Physical Education
