Year 4 Learning Journey Summer Term 2 June-July 2024

This half term we will be learning

English

This term we will be studying 'Billy the Kid' by Michael Morpurgo. We will focus on GPS and writing through the forms of newspaper reports and narratives with alternative endings. Handwriting will continue to be a focus.



Maths

We will continue learning our times tables to 12 and how to multiply and divide by each number. We will be exploring the topics of money, length, mass and volume, area and perimeter and position and movement.

Religious Education

Building Bridges- we will continue to look at how we build bridges of friendship as well as the importance of admitting right and wrong and being reconciled with God and one another.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about electricity. The children will investigate how circuits and switches work and what materials are insulators and conductors.

Geography

In Geography, we will be studying the USA. We will be locating the USA on a map as well as learning about the climate and the physical landscape. We will also conduct case studies on the states of California and New York to allow for a comparison between the geographical features of both states.
