Maths - Consolidation Topics

Comparing volume, measuring in litres and millilitres and solving problems.

Time - Problem solving methods

R.E. (New Scheme 'To Know you more clearly.')

We will read the The parable of the Good Samaritan (Lk 10:25-37) We will think about the ways that Christians come together to support the local community. We will begin to recognise links and simple connections between some Jewish religious laws, beliefs, worship, and life. (e.g., keeping the Sabbath day holy and how this is celebrated in the synagogue and in Jewish homes).

English

We will be reading a selection of books by Antony Browne. We will be writing our own stories in the style of Antony Browne. We will continue our weekly GPS lessons, revising over a variety of punctuation marks, tenses and subordination. We will be writing some poems about different climates.

History - 'They Made a Difference'

This unit focuses on individuals from the past and present who have made a difference to society. Each individual has taken a stand against injustice and has made courageous acts against unfairness. The significant individuals pupils will study have been chosen for their contribution to justice and fairness for all. They are civil rights activists who have fought to bring about a positive change to our world.

Striking & Fielding
