This digraph can be can be found at the beginning and in the middle of words. The only common English word ending in 'ou' is you.</p>	<p>Learn for a test on Tue 7th May</p> <p>The digraph 'ie' making the /aɪ / sound as in pie.</p>	<p>Learn for a test on 13th May</p> <p>The digraph 'ie' making the /ee/ sound.</p>
