## Phonics and Spelling



Children will continue with the Read, Write, Inc Phonics scheme.

We will begin our weekly spelling test after October half term once the children have settled in.

## English



This half term the children will continue to develop their basic writing skills whilst exploring different genres of writing. We will be focussing on letter formation and basic punctuation whilst enjoying 'We're going on a bear hunt.' By Michael Rosen.



## Physical Education



In our PE lessons we will be learning and perfecting our fundamental movement skills. We will also be working on our team building skills.



## Maths



Our Maths learning will include:

- Count to 10, forwards and backwards from any given number.
- Count, read and write numbers to 10 in numerals and words.
- Make number bonds
- Add using number bonds
- Solving picture problems
- Subtract by crossing out
- Subtract using number bonds
- Solving subtraction problems

## Religious Education



This half term we will begin our first branch of our religious learning. This branch is titled 'Creation and Covenant.' In this branch, pupils will encounter the God who creates and calls a people. They will explore revelation of the Christian belief that all that is comes from God, the Creation accounts in Genesis, and scientific explanations of the process of Creation. They will explore the call of God and his covenantal relationship with his people first through Abraham and Moses, then through the narrative of the Old Testament.

## Science

In science this half term we will be studying materials where we will distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made. We will also identify and name a variety of everyday materials and describe their simple physical properties.



## PSHE/RSE

Journey In Love- We will discuss the ways that our family shows us love and care.

No Outsiders - We will discuss the importance of liking the way we are. We will also talk about how we can be inclusive to both boys and girls.



## Art

In art we will be exploring colours. We will identify primary colours and make a secondary colour wheel by mixing paint. Our focus will be on the work of Clarice
