



## READING PLUS INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Our school is using the Reading Plus program to help your child become a better reader. Reading Plus helps students develop the skills they need to be proficient readers and lifelong learners. Through regular Reading Plus practice, reading will become easier, comprehension will increase, and your child will make meaningful connections between reading and learning. Your child can complete Reading Plus assignments outside of school on a computer or tablet with Internet access. Assignments in each component can be completed in any order, but please remind your child that Reading lessons are the most important assignments. The program will keep track of assignments completed each week as well as your child's progress toward the overall lesson goals.

As this is part of your child's home learning journey we expect children to complete 3 lessons per week. 2 Reading lessons and a vocab lesson, this should take around 30 minutes to complete and can be spread out across the week. Reading Plus is checked daily by the class teacher to ensure it is being completed regularly.

Each week a Reading Plus champion is awarded a hot chocolate prize for their efforts! Assignments are reset at 12:00am every Monday therefore to allow children who complete homework over the weekend Reading Plus champions will be announced on a Monday.
