English

Our English work this term will be centred around the novel, 'A

Developing our skille and for some working hard to reach our 25m goal.


<u>Baskethall</u> – We will be developing our skille in ball control and passing, attack and defence drille and our aim for scoring points.

Mathematics

For this half term we have just began our unit of work on multiplication and division. Later in the term they will be applying their knowledge to solve word problems. It is vital that all pupils are fluent in all the times tables so any extra practice at all would be very much valued.

PSHE/RSE
