Learn for a test on 28 th April The short vowel sound /e/ spelt ea.	Learn for a test on Tue 6 th May The 'ou' digraph. This digraph can be can be found at the beginning and in the middle of words. The only common English word ending in 'ou' is you.	Learn for a test on 12 th May The digraph 'ie' making the /aɪ / sound as in pie.	Learn for a test on 19 th May The digraph 'ie' making the /ee/ sound.
