Autumn Term 1 2025



Maths

This half term we will be covering the following topics:

- Numbers to 10,000
- Addition and subtraction within 10,000

Times tables will be tested on a weekly basis every Monday. Children should practice these at home regularly to build fluency in preparation for the Multiplication Tables Check later this year.

RSHE

We will be learning to understand that God loves us all even though we are all different and starting to celebrate our own differences that make us all special.

No Outsiders

We will be learning about who we want to be and recognise why people sometimes don't speak up. We will also learn about how everyone in our school should be proud of who they are.

PSHE

We will be learning to develop an understanding of courtesy and manners in a range of situations.

Science

Teeth and Digestion—We will look at teeth and what happens if we do not look after them correctly. We will look at how animal teeth are different to ours. Finally, we will begin to explore our digestion system and what happens inside our bodies.

PE

This half term we will be focusing upon fundamentals and team building. PE days will be Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Please remember to label all PE kits fully as well as water bottles.

English

We will be focusing on the novel, 'The Wild Robot' as well as 'Little People, Big Dreams: Marie Curie'.

We will use these books to create the following:

- Diary entry
- Formal letter
- Biography

Please continue to read daily at home choosing books of interest. This is good practice as we move through Year 4. School reading books must be read at home 3 times a week and returned to school every Friday. Reading Plus should also be completed 3 times a week. Spellings will be tested in school every Monday.

Art

We will be exploring Sculpture-Mega materialsexploring three dimensional shapes, using tools to model and refine a sculpture.

Religious Education

Creation and Covenant - We will learn how God made the world and loves each of us, starting with the stories in Genesis. We will hear that everything comes from God and that He invites us to be part of His family. We will also learn to look after creation and think about how being kind to God's world shows our faith.

Music

The children will begin with class singing lessons which will focus on rhythm and pitch. These lessons will take place each Tuesday.

History

Romans-The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.

We will be looking at key figures such as Julius

Caesar and Boudicca.
