Learn for a test on 6.11.25 Spelling Rules: The /ar/ digraph. This digraph may be used at the beginning, middle or end of words.	Learn for a test on 13.11.25 Spelling Rules: Long vowel sound /e/ spelt ee. The letters 'ee' make a long vowel sound like in the word see. This is a common way of spelling the sound and is found in the middle of words and sometimes at the end.	Learn for a test on 18.11.24 Spelling Rules: The vowel digraph 'er'. In these words the sound is stressed.	Learn for a test on 20.11.25 Spelling Rules: The vowel digraph 'er'. In these words the sound is unstressed and found at the end of words.	Learn for a test on 27.11.25 Spelling Rules: The ai digraph. This digraph is virtually never used at the end of words in English.	Learn for a test on 4.12.24 Spelling Rules: The long vowel sound /oo/ as in zoo.	Learn for a test on 11.12.25 Spelling Rules: The oi digraph. This digraph is virtually never used at the end of words in English.
