RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This half term we will move onto our third branch of religious learning. This branch is titled 'Galilee to Jerusalem.' In this branch, pupils will experience the Ministry of Jesus, the word of God. They will learn about the life of Jesus and his revelation of the Kingdom of God through parables, encounters, miracles and teachings. They will learn about the call of the disciples and the nature of being a follower of Jesus.

PHONICS



Children will continue with the Read, write, Inc. phonics scheme. They will be taught all the sounds to help them read words. They will also be taught how to segment words to spell.

ENGLISH

In English this half term we will explore the picture books 'Katie in London' by James Mayhew and 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' by Judith Kerr. We will be continuing to develop our writing skills by writing diary entries, shopping lists and a short narrative. Our focus this half term will be using our phonetic knowledge to spell unfamiliar words and writing short sentences independently.



SCIENCE

We will be studying the common animals which the children may see or read about regularly. We will talk about their similarities and difference as well as group/classify animals into categories.

MATHS

- Use existing knowledge to create addition and subtraction fact families
- Explore the properties of shape and patterns
- Compare lengths of objects
- Use a ruler to measure length of objects
- Begin to focus on numbers 0-40



MUSIC

We will be focussing our music on the topic of superheroes. We will be using musical instruments to explore pitch and tempo.

ART



In Art and Design we will develop skills in manipulating paper and card. We create simple 3D shapes and structures using familiar materials. We will work towards making our own sculptures by folding, rolling and scrunching materials.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Mr Hathaway we will explore and develop fundamental ball skills, such as throwing, catching, rolling and dribbling with both hands and feet. With Mrs Regan we will be exploring movement through dance.
