English

We will be reading 'Matilda' this half term and the children will be writing some instructions and writing descriptively using their senses. We will continue teaching GPS within these lessons including commas, direct speech and imperative verbs.

Spellings and Times Tables

Spelling lists can be found on our year group page on the website. We will start testing the children on their 10 times tables this half term.

Religious Education

Our scriptures will be:

- Jesus enters Jerusalem
- The Last Supper
- The Crucifixion and death of Jesus
- The angel's message
- Peter at the tomb

We will learn that Jesus gave us the Sacrament of Reconciliation to heal and restore our friendship with God and through this ourselves. We will think about how Lent is a time of preparing our hearts and minds for Easter through reconciliation and forgiveness.

Maths

- We will be investigating the properties of both 2D and 3D shapes, looking at their faces, vertices and edges.
- We will be completing activities involving fractions, focusing on halves, quarters and thirds. Children will be using concrete manipulatives and real life representations in their learning of fractions.

Geography - Planet Earth (continued)

- What is the continent of Africa like?
- What is the continent of Asia like?
- What is the continent of Antarctica like?
- Why are some parts of the Earth hot and some parts cold?

Art - 'Life in Colour'

This topic explores how artists use colour to express ideas, feelings, and observations of the world around them. Pupils experiment with mixing primary and secondary colours, study the work of artists who use bold and expressive palettes, and apply their skills through drawing, painting, and collage.
