<p>Learn for a test on 4th June</p> <p>The /or/ sound spelt with the digraph <i>ow</i> or <i>ou</i>. If it is at the end of a word it is more likely to be spelt with an <i>ow</i> and at the beginning of a word with <i>ou</i>.</p>	<p>Learn for a test on 11th June</p> <p>The 'ow' digraph. This digraph can make two different sounds like in 'cow' or in 'blow'.</p>	<p>Learn for a test on 18th June</p> <p>The 'oo' and 'you' sounds can be spelt as <i>u-e</i>, <i>ue</i> and <i>ew</i>. If words end in the /oo/ sound, then it is likely that they will be spelt <i>ew</i> or <i>ue</i>.</p>	<p>Learn for a test on 25th June</p> <p>The trigraphs 'air' and 'ear'. These spellings are commonly found in the middle or at the end of words but can sometimes be used at the beginning of words too.</p>	<p>Learn for a test on 2nd July</p> <p>The /air/ sound spelled with 'ear' or 'are'</p>	<p>Learn for a test on 9th July</p>
