Welcome to Year 2!

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Year 2! We are looking forward to a fantastic year ahead!

Spelling lists are issued on a half termly basis and each list should be learnt for the date on the top of the list. Spellings will be tested on a Wednesday. Should you misplace your spelling list, you will find a copy on our school website on the Year 2 page. There are 2 groups for spellings and your child will bring their list home.

The children are expected to know by heart their $\times 2$, $\times 5$ and $\times 10$ tables by the end of Year 2. We will begin to test the children after half term, starting with the $\times 2$ tables. Tables will also be tested on a Wednesday.

The children are heard read daily through our RWI sessions. Some children will be heard read in addition to their guided session by our LSA, Mrs. Crennell. It is the responsibility of the children to ensure they hand their book in to be changed. There is a box in each class for books to be placed in on a Friday morning, record books must be signed by parents to say that they have heard their child read the book. New books will be sent home on a Monday. Children should be changing 1 book a week in Year 2.

Year 2's P.E. days are on Monday's and Thursday's and children are allowed to come to school in their school P.E. kit and trainers.

The KS1 children are all provided with a piece of fresh fruit each morning at break time but are allowed to bring a piece of fruit from home. No other snacks are permitted. Please remember to label all uniform including water bottles, coats and hats etc.

Please avoid letting the children bring in things from home like key rings, lip balms, pencil cases etc.
